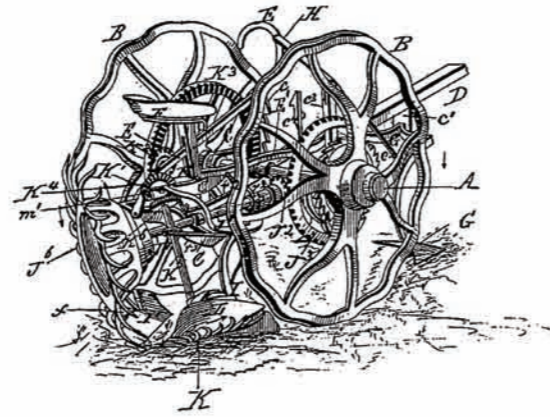
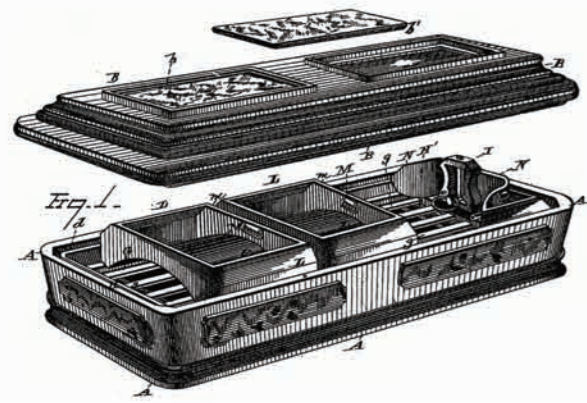

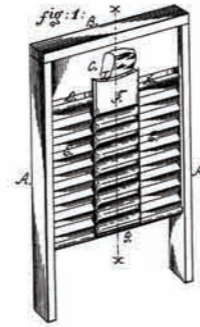
Although many of the inventors and inventions of Saratoga County have been forgotten, their stories are woven into the fabric of its history. Within these pages are detailed accounts of:

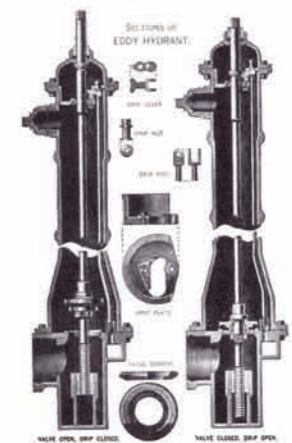
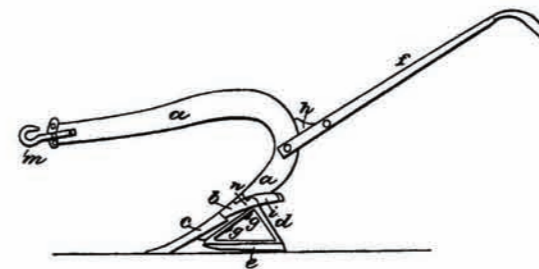
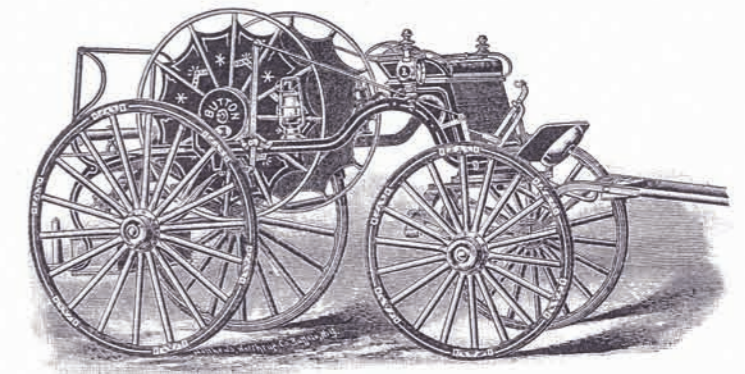
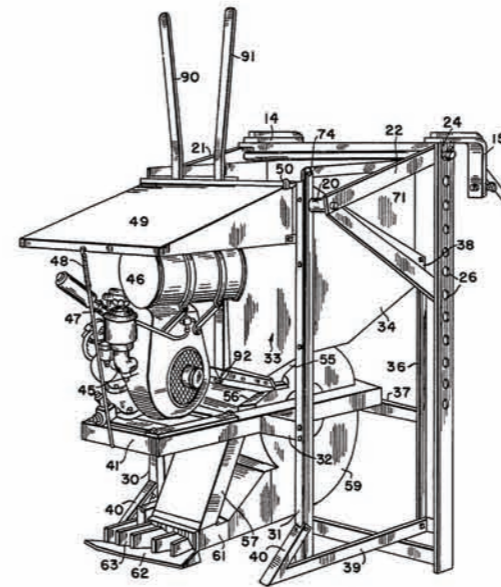


FIG. 140.—Eddy Fire Hydrant.
